## Rhythm:



DrumJam (iOS) - \$10.99

- comes with a library of percussion tracks on instruments from a variety of cultures
- each instrument has a selection of 20 different beat patterns
- can adjust volume of individual tracks, beats per bar and bpm



Drumbeats+ (iOS and Android) - Free - in app purchase of \$20.99 unlocks all loops


- a variety of different drum loops
- can save favourites
- can alter bpm 45 200



Super Metronome Groovebox Pro (iOS and Android) - \$9.99

- a metronome that includes drum grooves
- bpm 40 250
- can adjust time signature

iTabla Pro (iOS) - \$34.99

- Tabla Tanpura player
- created for Indian Classical musicians but can function as a tuning note drone for any instrument or voice

### **Rhythm and Harmony:**



**Groovebox by Novation (iOS) - Free with in app purchases** 

- builds beats with harmonic background in major/minor/modes
- can adjust bpm and keys

## **Learning Aids:**



Amazing Slow Downer (iOS and Android) - \$20.99

- is able to slow down recordings without losing the pitch
- also has the ability to adjust pitch without changing tempo
- sections of a piece can be isolated and played in a loop
- load recordings via iTunes and Spotify

Staff Wars (iOS and Android) - \$1.39

- a game-based app to help with note accuracy

#### **Sheet Music on the Tablet:**



Scanner Pro (iOS and Android) - \$5.49

- uses camera to create scans
- ideal for capturing images of text and sheet music



ForScore (for iPad) - \$13.99

- handles sheet music in pdf form
- able to annonate within app
- able to create categories and setlists to manage files
- add files by scanning directly from device (using the camera) or while connected to computer via iTunes
